- Read emails and newsletters sent by the school
- Encourage reading and learning at home
- Ensure students arrive to school on time and minimize absences

- Avoid unexcused absences
- Request help and clarification from teachers and tutors
- Check emails and Google Classroom daily for assignments and announcements
- Attend tutoring and take advantage of assignment or test retakes
- Participate in enrichment opportunities
