What is Title One?

David C. Barrow Elementary School is identified as a Title One school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act. Title One is designed to support state and local school reform efforts tied to challenging state academic standards and to reinforce and enhance efforts to improve teaching and learning for students. Title One programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support parental involvement. All Title One schools must jointly develop with all parents a written parental involvement policy.

Family Engagement Plan

What is it?

This is a plan that describes how Barrow Elementary will provide opportunities to improve parent engagement to support student learning. Barrow values the contributions and involvement of parents to establish an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes the different ways that Barrow will support parent engagement and how parents can help plan and participate in activities and events to promote student learning at school and at home.

How is it revised?

Barrow invites families, staff, and stakeholders to attend our annual Title One Family Engagement Input Planning meeting every spring to review and revise this Family Engagement Plan as well as the school-wide plan, our family-school compact, and the parental involvement budget. This information is posted on our school website for parents to view and feedback is accepted throughout the year. All parent feedback will be used to revise the plan for the next school year. Families can also give feedback during family engagement events, at school activities, through direct contact with staff and administration, and during Fall and Spring Parent-Teacher Conferences.

Who is it for?

All students participating in the Title One, Part A program and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Barrow will provide full opportunity for the participation of all parents including those speaking limited English, parents with disabilities and parents of migratory children. Information about revision opportunities will come home in the Monday folder.

Where is it available?

The plan is found online in the "For Families<Family Engagement" section of the school's website. It is also provided to all parents at Fall Parent-Teacher Conferences and is available anytime in the school's Family Resource Center, which is located across from the front office.

Family-School Compact

Barrow and our families will develop a family-school compact. It's an agreement which parents, teachers and students develop that explains how parents and teachers will work together to make sure all our students reach grade-level standards. The compact will be reviewed and updated annually based on feedback obtained throughout the year from parents, students, and teachers as well as during the Title One Input Planning meeting in the spring. During Fall Conferences parents will receive the compact, discuss its contents with their child's teacher, and all parties will sign. During Spring Conferences the compact will be revisited to assess its impact on learning at home.
- Collect feedback from parents at all events. Provide families ample opportunities to have their voices heard through multiple means of communication and ensure families are aware of school happenings through calendars, Class Dojo, emails, phone calls, and online postings.
