- Student and Staff COVID testing
  - CCSD is planning a potential partnership with UGA to provide testing for symptomatic students and staff.

#### School Reopening: Pathway to <u>Full</u> Reopening



CCSD will conduct school/department vaccination days for staff that are interested in receiving the vaccine.

CCSD will review county positivity rate: below 5% or less than 200/100k.

\*SPED may return before this threshold is met.

Phase 3 March 15	4 days per week M/T and Th/F; W-Remote Learning			Continues Remote Learning	Phased In Cohort Model *Gradual increase in in-person days as appropriate.
Phase 4 March 22		4 days per week M/T and Th/F; W-Remote Learning			



A virtual option will be available to families for the remainder of the year.

#### **Special Education**

- Two week phase in plan
- Special Education Programs
  - Adaptive (M/T)
  - SPED Pre Kindergarten
  - CABER (M/T)
  - Compass/Rise (M/T and Th/Friday)
  - Deaf and Hard of Hearing (M/T and Th/Friday)
- 16 campus sites
  - 11 ES sites, including OEL
  - 3 MS sites
  - 2 HS sites



#### Preparation for OEL, PreK-Grade 12

- Reopening registration for parents with due date of February
  11, 2021.
  - Instructional model selection will last until the end of the year.
- Elementary, middle school bell schedules will remain the same.
- High schools will have a reduced school scheduled, 9 a.m.-1 p.m.
- Students will receive synchronous and/or asynchronous instruction when not in school.



#### School Reopening: Increased Mitigation

- Provide the vaccine to all staff
- Smaller numbers of students and staff in building for extended amount of time.
- Wednesday will be designated as a cleaning day and an opportunity to conduct contact tracing if needed.
- COVID testing for symptomatic staff and students
- Additional face shields for all staff
