Online Learning Survey

In partnership with the University of Georgia (UGA), the Clarke County School District (CCSD) asks students in Grades 3-12 to participate in an online survey. The survey is about your child's school connection, resilience, and experience with online learning. The survey results will be used to help CCSD understand how the COVID-19 pandemic has affected your child and improve its effectiveness for supporting students during extended periods of online learning.

The survey will be administered online on a date selected by the principal in the coming weeks. The survey will take 15-20 minutes for the students to complete, and the survey is anonymous and designed to protect your child's privacy.

The survey is voluntary, and students and parents can opt-out of participation by contacting the student's teacher. Students may skip questions they do not wish to answer. Students may stop participating in the survey at any point without penalty.
