CCSD by the Numbers

- Schools = 21
- Students = 13,000+
- Staff = 2280
- General budget = \$175,000,000, balanced
- Debt remaining on SPLOST bond:
\$43,300,000



Sources for Funding Growth

- **Property Tax**
 - 20.00 millage rate (2016)
- **E-SPLOST**
 - One-cent sales tax (a consumption tax) on goods paid by all who shop, stay, dine, or receive services in Clarke County, including outside visitors.
 - ACC government taxes and SPLOST/Bond Referendums are not related to the school system; each is a separate government entity.



What is E-SPLOST?

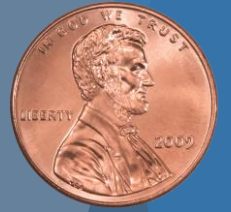


- One-cent sales tax on goods paid by all who shop, stay, dine, or receive services in Clarke County, including outside visitors.
- School systems must ask permission (through a referendum) from voters to implement an E-SPLOST.
- Expires after five years or until the established cap is reached.
- CCSD voters approved E-SPLOST referendums in 1997, '01, '06, '11, and '16.



What is E-SPLOST?

- By law, E-SPLOST funds can only be used for capital projects for educational purposes and to make payments on bonds.
- E-SPLOST funds cannot be used to pay operating expenses, such as salaries.
- Current E-SPLOST (V) expires DEC 2021.

Tier One

- Oglethorpe Ave. Elem.
- Hilsman Middle
- Coile Middle
- Clarke Middle
- BHL Middle
- Building systems renewal
- District, school, classroom technology infrastructure

Tier Two

- Building additions to accommodate enrollment growth (Chase, Gaines, Whitehead)
- School bus purchases

Tier Three

- Cedar Shoals High Improvements
- Extracurricular Activity Improvements
- District Office
- School Nutrition and other support functions



E-SPLOST V - Completed

- Cedar Shoals High - Locker rooms and old gym upgrades (Fall 19)
- Clarke Central High - Softball concession/press box, field upgrades (9/19)
- Hilsman Middle - New build (9/19)
- BHL Middle - Renovations (3/19)
- Coile Middle - Renovations (3/19)
- ACCA Cosmetology Lab (12/18)
- Oglethorpe Ave Elementary - New build (Fall 18)
