LOGISTICS ANNOUNCED FOR HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL GAME BETWEEN CEDAR SHOALS AND CLARKE CENTRAL

Athens, Georgia — School administrators announced the logistical details for the football game between Cedar Shoals and Clarke Central, scheduled for Friday, September 4.

Following guidelines provided by the Georgia High School Association, the stadium capacity will be reduced, and attendees must pre-purchase tickets and follow safety guidelines, including wearing masks and adhering to social distance requirements.

	 Seniors at Clarke Central and Cedar Shoals: 200 tickets are allotted for each school's seniors. Seniors will be able to purchase one (1) ticket on Monday, 8/31, from 8:00 a.m. until 11:59 p.m. Seniors must use their lunch number to gain access to purchase the ticket. 	
	 Tickets for General Public: Beginning 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, 9/1, the remaining balance of the tickets will be sold on a first-come, first- serve basis. 	

	• Spectators must show a ticket (on their phone) to be allowed on the Cedar Shoals campus.	
	No in/out privileges – once a spectator leaves the stadium, they will not be allowed to re-enter.	
	 CCSD staff will not be allowed to use their staff badge to gain admittance. 	
Parking/Security	 Cedar Shoals campus will be closed to anyone who does not have a ticket.
