

School Reopening Update

Dear Clarke County School District Community,

The purpose of this communication is to provide an update regarding decisions for reopening school.

- 1. Thursday, July 16, the Board of Education will hold a called meeting to discuss changing the school calendar. The district cannot make any decisions regarding a proposed new start date (or subsequent calendar changes) without board approval.
- 2. Registration to select in-person or distance/digital learning will be postponed until a start date has been approved.
- 3. Friday, July 17, the Task Force will communicate the school start date and additional details on instructional options.
- 4. Staff and parents will have the opportunity to provide feedback as planning continues. The Task Force will conduct virtual "Town Hall" style meetings with CCSD staff and parents/guardians.
- 5. There is a new menu item on the district website titled "<u>Reopening Info</u>," containing all of the information made public to date. The Task Force created a <u>FAQ</u> document to address some of the common questions/answers. The Task Force will continue to provide updates as decisions are finalized.
