CCSD BOE POLICY MEETING AND WORK SESSION ON MARCH 4 REMAINS VIRTUAL

Board Members Will Meet In-Person at Regular Meeting on March 11

March 3, 2021

(ATHENS, GA)- The Clarke County School District (CCSD) announced today that the Board of Education (BOE) will continue to meet virtually due to concerns regarding the COVID-19 pandemic for its scheduled Policy Committee Meeting and its Work Session on March 4.

The BOE's Policy Committee Meeting begins at 4:30 p.m., and the Work Session follows at 6 p.m. Both meetings will be livestreamed on the CCSD YouTube Live channel found [HERE](#) or located at: <https://www.youtube.com/c/clarkecoschools/videos>

American Sign Language (ASL) interpreters will be translating the meetings in real-time.

The CCSD also announced that Board members will transition back to in-person meetings beginning at its Regular Meeting on March 11, which will be held at the Athens Community Career Academy beginning at 6 p.m. It will be the first in-person meeting for Board Members since March 5, 2020.

Although BOE Regular, Work, and Committee Meetings were open to the public prior to the pandemic, the March 11 Regular Board Meeting will remain closed as the CCSD continues to follow recommended social distancing and close contact guidelines as outlined by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and other health agencies.

The March 11 Board meeting will be livestreamed on the district's YouTube Live channel and archived later for future viewings. ASL interpreters will translate in real-time.
