ARPA Information for CCSD

- Passed on March 6, 2021U.S. Congress
- \$4 Billion provided to Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE)
 - Funds released April 2021 GaDOE
- \$48,517,883.00 CCSD Allocation (\$0 expended as of May 2021)
 - Requirement (20% -mandatory minimum for learning loss \$9,703,577.00)

Feedback from All Stakeholders (Students, Parents, Staff & Community)

- What suggestions do you have on programming, staffing, professional learning, and social emotional supports?
 - Federal/State Guidelines require that all allocated funds align to research-based interventions and strategies (Moderate to Strong Effectiveness)
 - Aligned to student growth and social emotional data
 - Build and support capacity of instructional staff
 - Ensure measurable outcomes through evaluative process



K-12 CARES Act Funding: \$411 million to support Georgia's Schools
